

# Child Employment Legislation

No child under 13 can be employed.

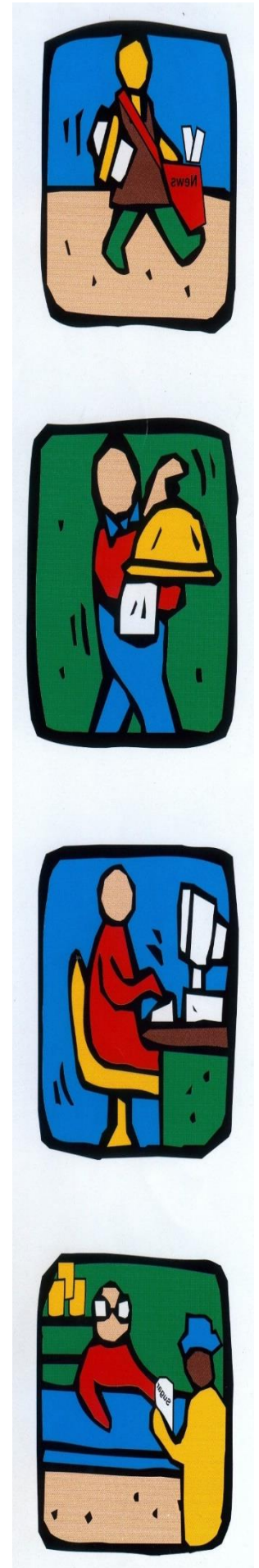
No child shall be employed in any occupation other than in an occupation specified in the Schedule.

No child of compulsory school age can work before 7:00 am or after 7:00 pm.

Employers must apply for a work permit for all child employees to the Children in Entertainment and Employment Team.

13 & 14 year olds	School days	Not more than 2 hours in one day, outside school hours this may include up to one hour before school.
	Saturday	5 hours a day
	Sunday	2 hours a day
	School Holidays	5 hours a day to a maximum of 27 hours a week  <b>The child must have at least 2 consecutive weeks off work between 1 July and 31 August.</b>

AGE	WHEN	HOW LONG
15 & 16 year olds	School days	Not more than 2 hours in one day, outside school hours this may include up to one hour before school
	Saturday	7 hours a day
	Sunday	2 hours a day
	School Holidays	7 hours a day to a maximum of 37 hours a week <b>The child must have at least 2 consecutive weeks off work between 1 July and 31 August.</b>
